



## **Case Study: Ancestry**



## **Overview**

Overseas South African national wished to relocate to the UK with his family on a long-term basis.

## **Our Advice**

Having ascertained that his grandparent was born in the UK, it was suggested that an entry clearance Ancestry application be prepared for himself, with separate dependent applications to be submitted for his wife and children. However, the client did not have evidence of relevant grandparent's UK birth/marriage nor a job offer or accommodation in the UK. It was therefore necessary for requests to be made of the General Register Office (GRO) to order duplicate UK birth and marriage certificates so as to be in a position to submit all mandatory evidence. Specific advice was given with regard to acceptable evidence required to demonstrate ability to work in UK and short-term accommodation to be provided by UK based relative as well as general advice concerning TB testing.

## Result

After arranging the necessary biometric appointments for the clients with the global administrative partner of the UKVI and uploading all supporting documentation on their behalf, the family were granted Ancestry visas to enter the UK. Upon their arrival the necessary Third Party Authorisation requests were submitted (to UKVI) for the children enabling the family to collect their Biometric Residence Permits valid for 5 years.
