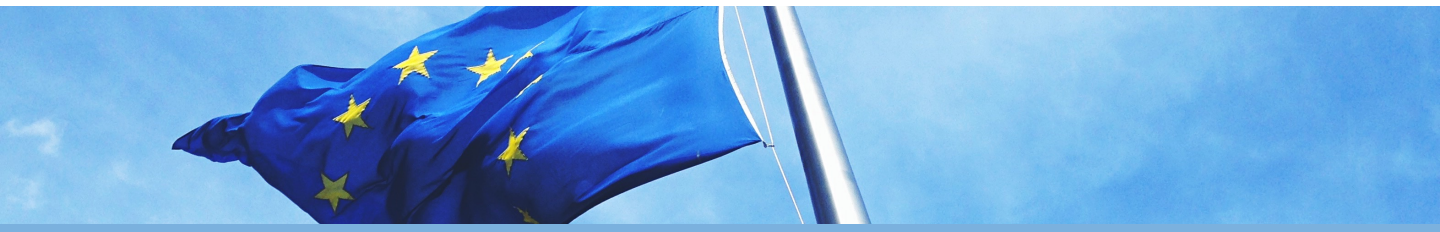


Case Study: European Union (EU)



Overview

Non-EU client held EEA Regulations Family Member permit, which had since expired. His EU wife and children had obtained settled status under Appendix EU but he was not included within that application as his passport had expired and he mistakenly believed he was not permitted to do so.

Our Advice

We advised our client to submit a 'late' EU settled status application in view of his continuous residence in the UK for the requisite period. We further advised that the application may be submitted using his expired identity document whilst his passport application remained pending. Specific advice was also provided with respect to the supporting documentation required to evidence his family relationship and continued residence.

Result

Having submitted substantive representations, together with a request for discretion in view of the belated nature of the application, our client was granted Settled Status under Appendix EU, in line with his family.
