



Overview

The family were temporarily in UK with visit visas and wished to remain in the UK on a long-term basis, with a view to settlement.

Our Advice

Having discussed at length the needs of the family as a whole, we ascertained that as the father primarily needed to be based overseas for business purposes, he would be best served by obtaining a multiple visit visa.

As the children wished to study in the UK we advised that the family should obtain child student visas from an independent school. As the children were over 12 years old, it was not possible for the mother to remain as the parent of child students, so it was suggested that in view of her existing qualifications, she enrol on a full-time course of study, enabling her to remain in the UK with her children, as well as furthering her career prospects.

Result

We obtained a Multiple Visit visa for the father, allowing him to visit his UK-based family. We liaised with the chosen independent school and secured Child Student visas. We obtained a Student visa for the mother and subsequently also obtained a Skilled Worker visa for the mother, with father and children joining as dependents, thereby ensuring the whole family is now on a five-year route to settlement.
